Do you have water? (Filled Water bottles)

Food and Supplies for at least 72 hours

Could you get on the radio if your power was out?

Can you program a reset radio? (Where's your manual?)

Are you batteries charged in your HT? Do you have a spare?

Can you go operate and deploy if needed (Radio, Antenna, coax and power source ready, food and personal supplies?) in less than 2 hours?

What is a Go-Kit?

An easily accessible kit of gear that can allow you to (deploy?) get on the air quickly.

It's not all just radio gear, there are go-kits for personal supplies and water to consider.

Radio Go-Kits

Here are some examples of what can be in your easily deployed go-kit

HT with charger and spare batteries

Mobile Rig for VHF/UHF with external antenna (mag mount)

Extra Coax

Power Supply and/or 12v battery?

HF Rig and antennas (think about how you would setup the antenna and what might be needed to do that, (ropes, trees. Masts. Tripod etc.)

Laptop or Tablet
